Our scheduled day is officially on Friday but after talking with the city, I found out they do also drive through on Thursday to check for pick-up. This occurs when they finish early with their previous account pick-up. Our covenants state in section 7.01, page 19 in part...refuse or trash shall be kept, stored or allowed to accumulate on any or part of the properties, except construction materials while building. If trash and refuse is to be disposed of by being picked up and carried away on a regular and returning basis, containers may be placed in the open, on any day that pick-up is to be made, at such place on the unit (property) to provide access to persons making such pick-up. ALL other items such as containers shall be stored in such a manner so that they cannot be seen from adjacent and surrounding property. This means putting yard debris out many days before pick-up is in violation. We ask for your cooperation. Please be mindful to not place yard debris in the street.
